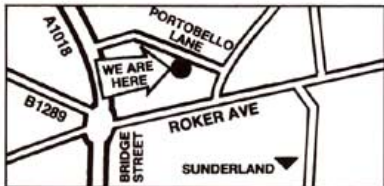
▼▼ *Hartley Wood hand blown glass enjoys a reputation second to none often described as the best glass in the world. The unique qualities of Hartley Wood glass are created by using the centuries old mouth blown process. First the craftsman blows a bubble in the glass, swinging, re-heating and blowing it longer, then cutting off the ends to convert it into a cylinder. By cutting along its length and then flattening it, a sheet of glass is produced. ▲▲*

▼▼ *Hartley Wood glassware is produced by the last remaining U.K. manufacturer of the world's finest antique sheet glass. Each piece is totally unique as it is hand-made by skilled glass blowers utilising centuries old colour mixes and manufacturing techniques.* ▲▲
